Start by describing the purpose of writing.



Provide evidence in support of your views - include necessary references, data, statistics or survey results.

Conclude with a hope or an appeal, or a warning or a suggestion, as required.



Stick to the word limit.



Proofread your letter and check it for accuracy of vocabulary, grammar and paragraphing before you send it.
